Care of the Earth--Water

The Great Lakes--Superior, Michigan, Huron, Erie and Ontario--and their connecting channels form the largest fresh surface water system on Earth. The familiar shapes of the lakes can be identified from the moon. Covering more than 94,000 square miles, these freshwater seas hold an estimated 6 quadrillion gallons of water--**20% of the world's fresh surface water supply and 90% of the U.S. supply.**

Spread evenly across the contiguous 48 states, the lakes' water would be about 9.5 feet deep.

Carol Mead has noted that “the **families have been deeply touched by the outpouring of love and prayers of our youth**”.

+ Virtual Rome Experience update: a two-year project accomplished by students of the Villanova University of Pennsylvania can bring part of the “Rome experience” right to your computer. The Sistine Chapel, St. Paul’s Outside the Walls, St. John Lateran and St. Peter’s are all available for viewing virtually at the Vatican web site. St. Peter’s is the last to have been posted; the Sistine Chapel went up in March. St. Paul’s was the first to be made available, in 2008, and St. John Lateran was completed last November. 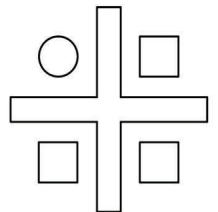
